

MERGING RACE AND GENDER THEORY WITH COMEDY, LYRICISM, AND RHYME SCHEMES, JAVON HAS BECOME A VERY AWARDED SPOKEN WORD/SLAM POET. JAVON BEGAN WRITING IN 2001, WINNING SLAM NATIONALS IN 2003 (TEAM Los Angeles), in 2004 (team Hollywood), in 2005 he placed 3rd (one OF A HANDFUL OF POETS TO MAKE FINALS THREE YEARS IN A ROW), AND RE-TURNING TO SLAM AFTER A BRIEF HIATUS, JAVON PLACED 5TH IN 2011, 4TH IN 2012, AND 2ND IN 2013 (TEAM HOLLYWOOD). JAVON HAS APPEARED ON HBO'S DEF POETRY JAM, BET'S LYRIC CAFÉ, TVONES VERSES & FLOW, AND CO-WROTE A DOCUMENTARY TITLED CROSSOVER, WHICH AIRED ON SHOWTIME, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE NBA AND NIKE. CURRENTLY ON A NATIONAL TOUR WITH FIVEOLOGY, A COLLECTIVE OF SPOKEN WORD POETS, JAVON IS SIMULTANEOUSLY A FEATURED BLOGGER FOR THE HUFFINGTON POST, AND CURRENTLY SERVES ON THE BOARD OF SAY WORD, AN ORGANIZATION THAT MENTORS TEENAGERS AND PROMOTES CREATIVE SELF-EXPRESSION THROUGH SPOKEN WORD POETRY IN LOS ANGELES. KEYNOTE MUSICIAN:

HUGH LEHANE



Hugh was born and raised in Ireland. He relocated to California in 2001. As a young man he was inspired by attending his first concert, with the Legendary Irish rock band Thin Lizzy. Hugh was so completely blown away by the experience, it was literally an artistic epiphany for him. He walked away that night knowing he had found his purpose in life. Moving forward, his artistic mission became simple, to give back, to inspire others, the way Thin Lizzy had inspired him.

Highlights of Hugh's time in Ireland as a musician include.

- * Chosen to perform for the Irish Prime Minister, at the International press launch of Europe's first Rock School.
- * After 5 years study became the head singing teacher at the Parnell School of Music.
- * Co-produced numerous music variety shows for The Parnell School of Music at the Rupert Guinness theater.
- * Touring with his band on an Irish & UK Heineken sponsored tour.
- * Performed at CBGB's New York & The Viper Room LA.
- * Signed with Foreigner manager Bud Prager's US management company.
- * Signed with Sony/Columbia Los Angeles.
- * Recorded with Producer Kevin Shirley (Aerosmith, Journey, Iron Maiden).

As an actor, back in Ireland, Hugh was involved in college theater productions as an actor & producer. He also earned the honor of auditioning personally for Film Director Alan Parker (Fame, Mississippi Burning, Evita), for Parkers feature film 'The Commitments'. He got this audition after a rigorous audition process that had literally thousands of hopefuls from all over Ireland.

Since relocating to California in 2001, Hugh has performed hundreds of solo shows all over the Southwest and while touring he has developed a very loyal following who call themselves the 'Hugh Nation'.

Hugh's music is the winner of multiple award nominations, including Toronto International, Southern California and Orange County Music Awards. He was also voted one of the 'Best Live' artists in Southern California and was described by Music Connection Magazine as "A standout player, with a voice that is astounding".

As an actor Hugh has a lead role in the award winning feature film, 'Gothic Assassins' ~ co-starring with Stephen Bauer (Scarface, Traffic, Breaking Bad). This film was described by the Toronto International Film Festival as "A brilliant film ahead of it's time". As well as having a lead role in this film Hugh also provides narration for the movie and all it's 4 trailers. 'Gothic Assassins' is currently in negotiation for worldwide distribution. Some of the International Film Festivals that Gothic Assassins has appeared at include Lucerne (Switzerland), Venice (Italy), Las Vegas, SITG-ES (Barcelona) & UK.

Hugh also has three other feature film projects happening right now. He voices the Lead Villain 'The Flea' in the superhero movies 'Antboy' and 'Antboy 2: Revenge Of The Red Fury' (both films also had a US & International theatrical release) and he voices multiple characters in the animated feature film 'Caroline and The Magic Potion'. Next up is Antboy 3!! and another animated feature film called 'The 3 Little Pigs & The Magic Lamp' All these feature films mentioned are now (or will be shortly) available on DVD, VOD, Netflix, Redbox, Amazon etc.

On NATIONAL TV Hugh just recently had a lead role in the crime drama 'Murder Book' playing a real life serial killer. He has also appeared on numerous other TV shows including 'Homicide Hunter' (Discovery) & 'Deadliest Warrior' (Spike TV).

As a video editor and filmmaker Hugh had one of his projects accepted into the Stepping Stone International Film Festival, India and he also produced a weekly vlog series for CMT's 'Sweet Home Alabama' star Jason Maxim. Currently he is working his first full length documentary film.

KEYNOTE PERFORMANCE: DR. RACHEL HASTINGS



Dr. Rachel N. Hastings is a practicing playwright, poet, performing artist and parent whose projects provide cultural knowledge and practical teaching tools to those who need it most. As an expert in Performance and Pedagogy, Dr. Hastings' work is centered in how people perform and communicate their racial, cultural and socio-political identities to best assist individuals in cultivating their own voice. Her recent research and performance projects apply what she calls a "critical creative approach" to teaching communication and performance to others. Since beginning her professorship in 2012 at Southwestern College, Dr. Hastings has led thousands of community college students and members of the surrounding communities into activating dialogue through the practice of service and outreach. Some of her projects include, designing and implementing The CAALI Project, a Communication Arts & African American Leadership Institute for students interested in a culturally-specific learning program; organizing a series of holiday wrap parties raising financial and material goods for children of incarcerated parents and the homeless; founding the critical reading collective, Soledad Scholars and bringing together college students and inmates of Folsom Prison through a series of literary publications; hosting The CAALI Conference where professional artists, scholars, community leaders, advocates, and students discussed the significance of

Black Performance to social change; and the recent curating of Dialogue, an interactive, multimedia art exhibit on the State of Black Men in America during February 2016. Hastings currently serves as the Pedagogy Curator for the online game, Love Lines, an interactive quiz designed to teach people how to navigate conflict within intimate relationships. Her work is published in Radical Philosophy Review, Women & Language, Liminalities, and The Nigerian Guardian, among others. As a result of these projects, Dr. Hastings aims to release her next performance advocacy, The MenStroll Cycles, Fall 2016.

The MenStroll Cycles: A Blackademik Dialoque

First public preview of some of the poems and scenes featured in The MenStroll Cycles.

The MenStroll Cycles is a fast-paced, rhythmic journey through black intelligencia by challenging the current state of Black Men in the United States as told through the voice of one black woman. Rarely are Black men and women publicly represented as allies against a common foe. Even with the rise of pop cultural texts that project positive images of family and friendship on T.V. and other social media, it is more often that Black men and women are positioned against one another in the political fight to achieve social and cultural equity with their counterparts. This performance not only counters the notion that Black men and women can't advocate and critique one another in positive and communicative ways, but also offers a critical Blackademik narrative about coming to understand the use of performance as an artistic act of political resistance.

Against the backdrop of daily acts of racial and cultural conflict, there is an important but often silent question being asked by those who want to be allies to the disenfranchised. How can I become a friend to a community that I care about but is not my own, while also preventing myself from being or becoming a future foe or enemy? Calling on audience members to engage in small acts of performative decolonization, Dr. Hastings offers some fun, practical tips on how to recognize (and defend yourself against) the "foenemies," while also forging friendship across unlikely borders.






